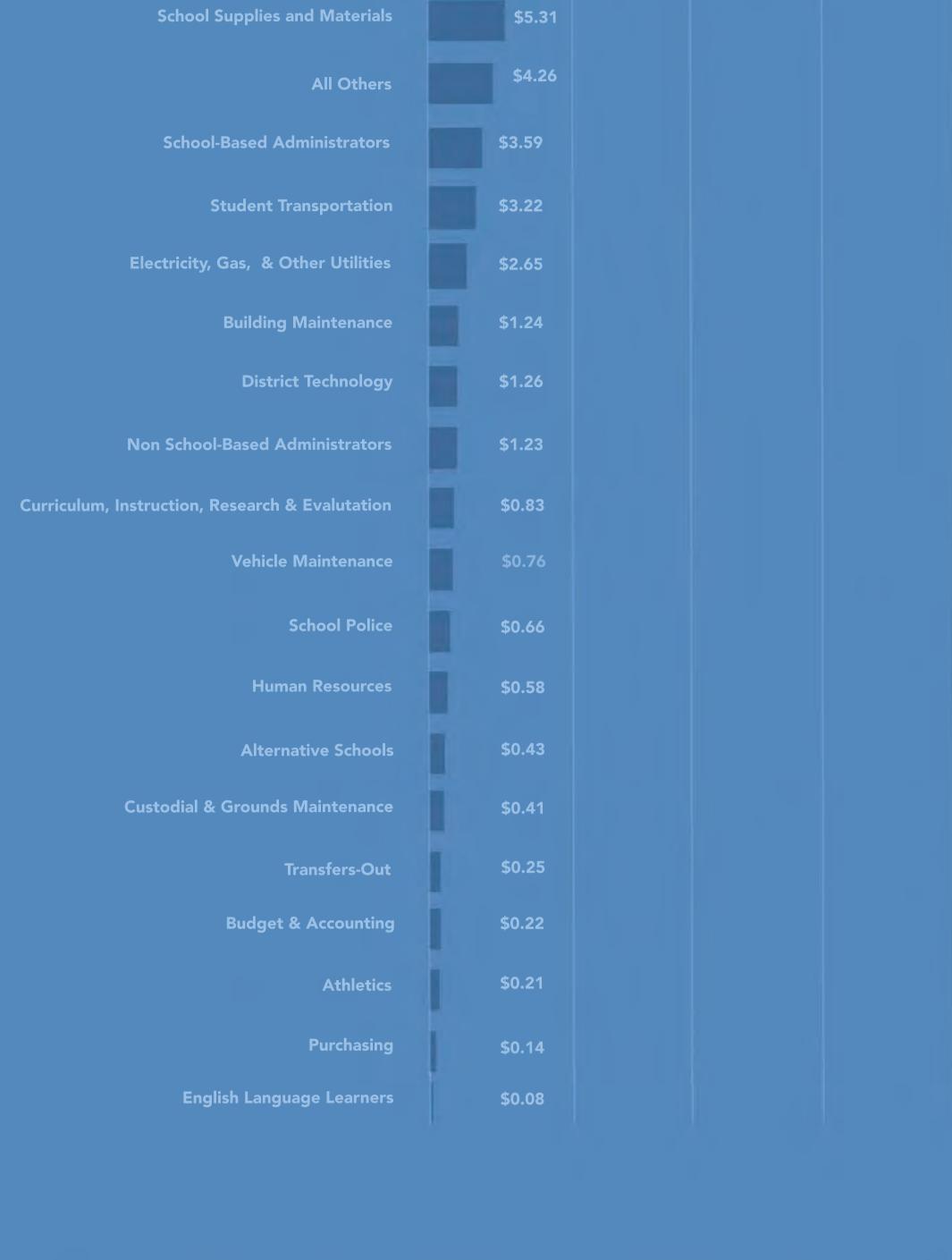
The District's annual general operating budget is \$3.70 billion. If that seems like a large number coonsider this: we spend less than half of what other school districts close in size and demographics
