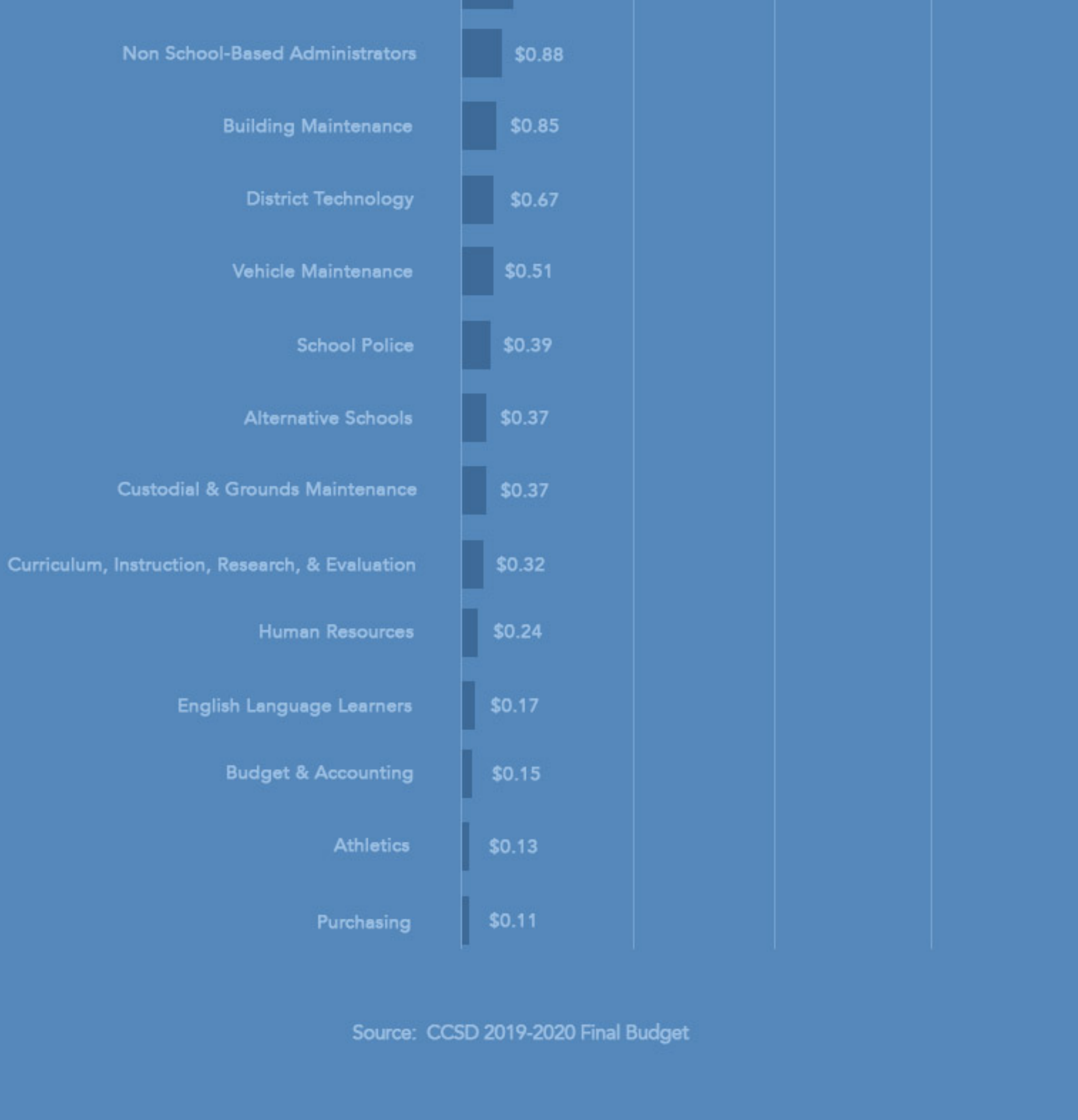
BREAKING DOWN THE BUDGET

The District's annual general operating budget is \$2.4 billion. If that seems like a large number consider this: we spend less than half of what other school districts close in size and demographics spend. Our \$2.4 billion budget broken out per student, per day helps put spending on expenditures like employees and supplies into perspective.

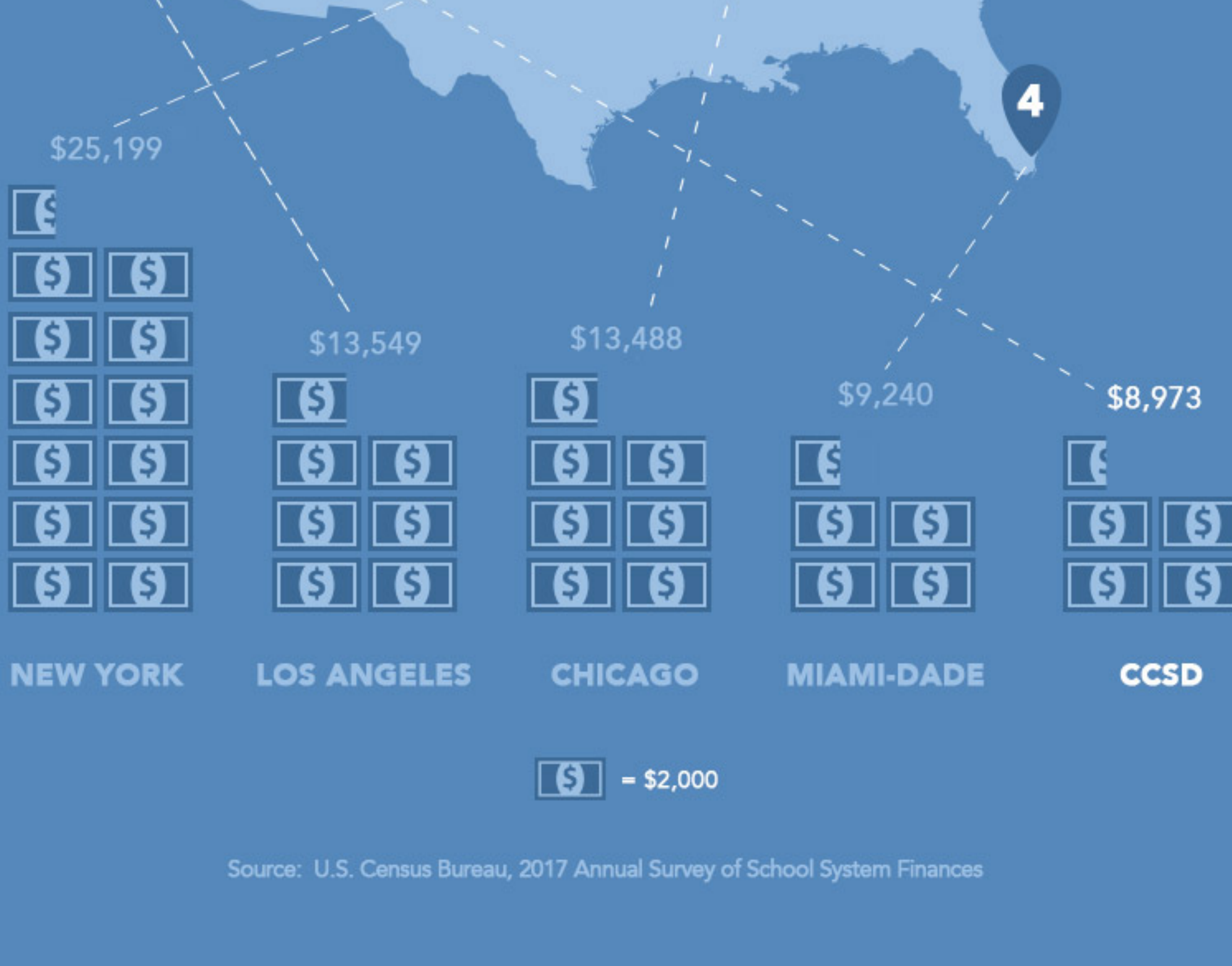
PER STUDENT. PER DAY.

SPENDING: COMPARING THE BIG FIVE

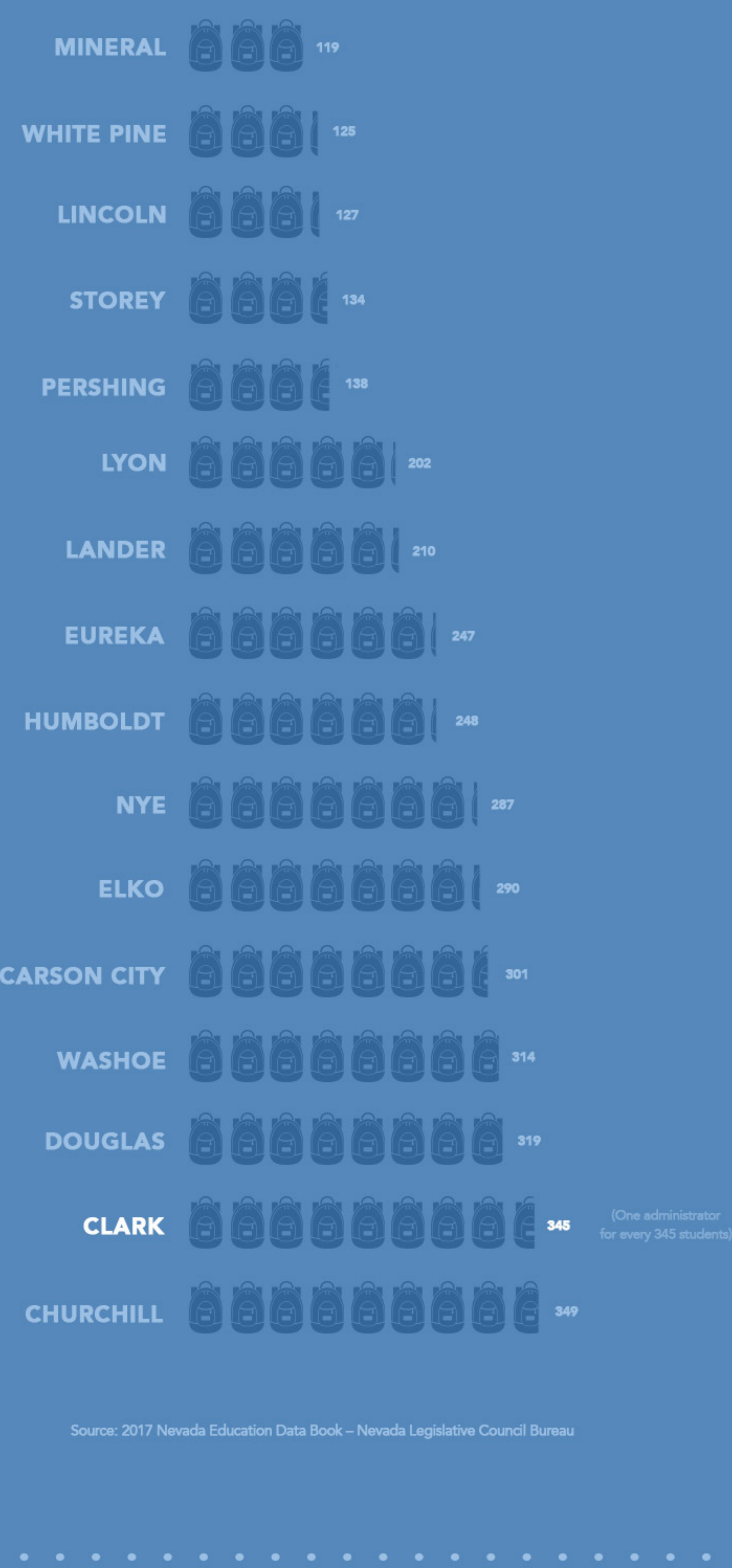

CCSD ranks 75th in per-pupil expenditures out of the top 100 largest school districts in the country. 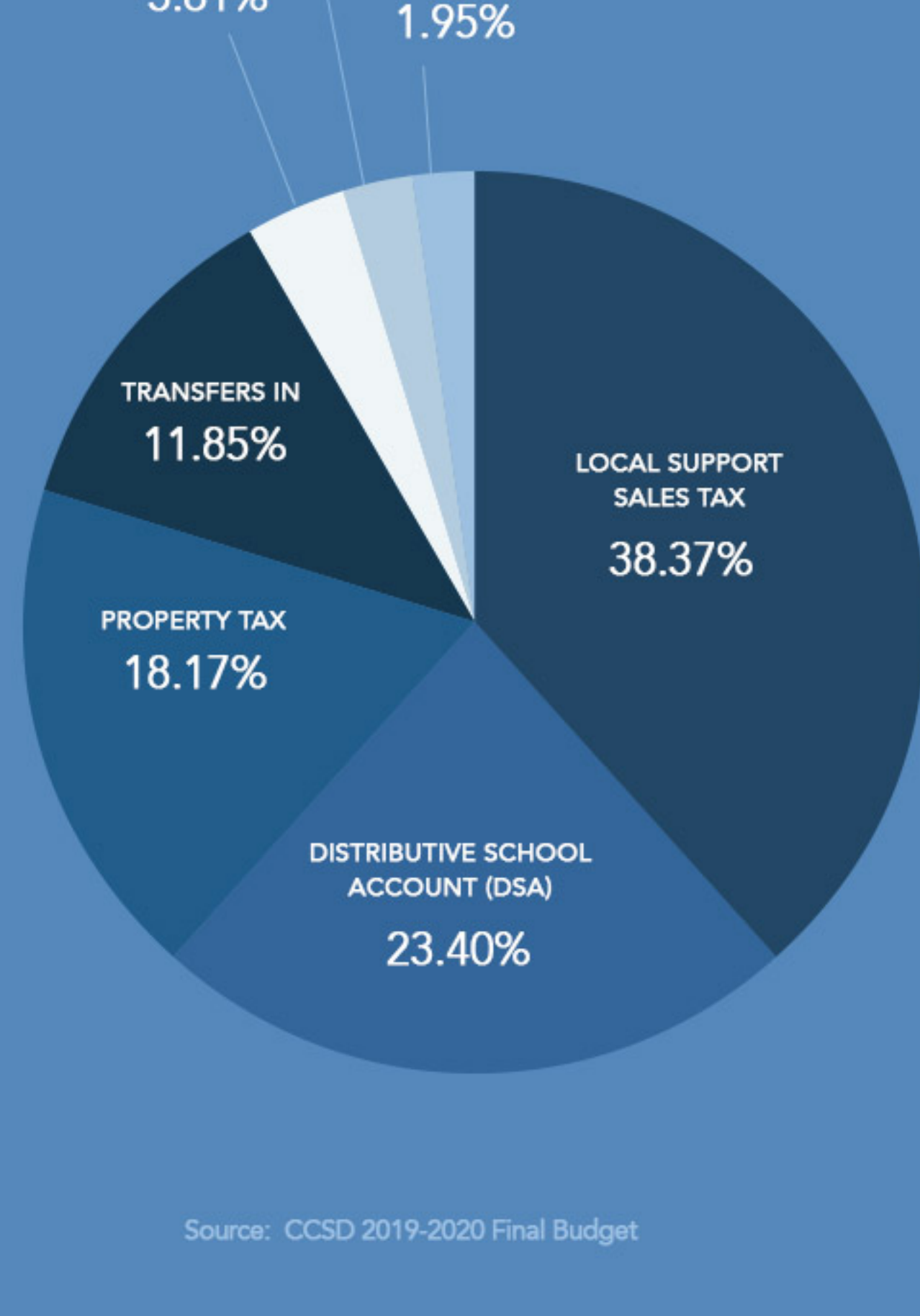

GENERAL OPERATING FUNDS

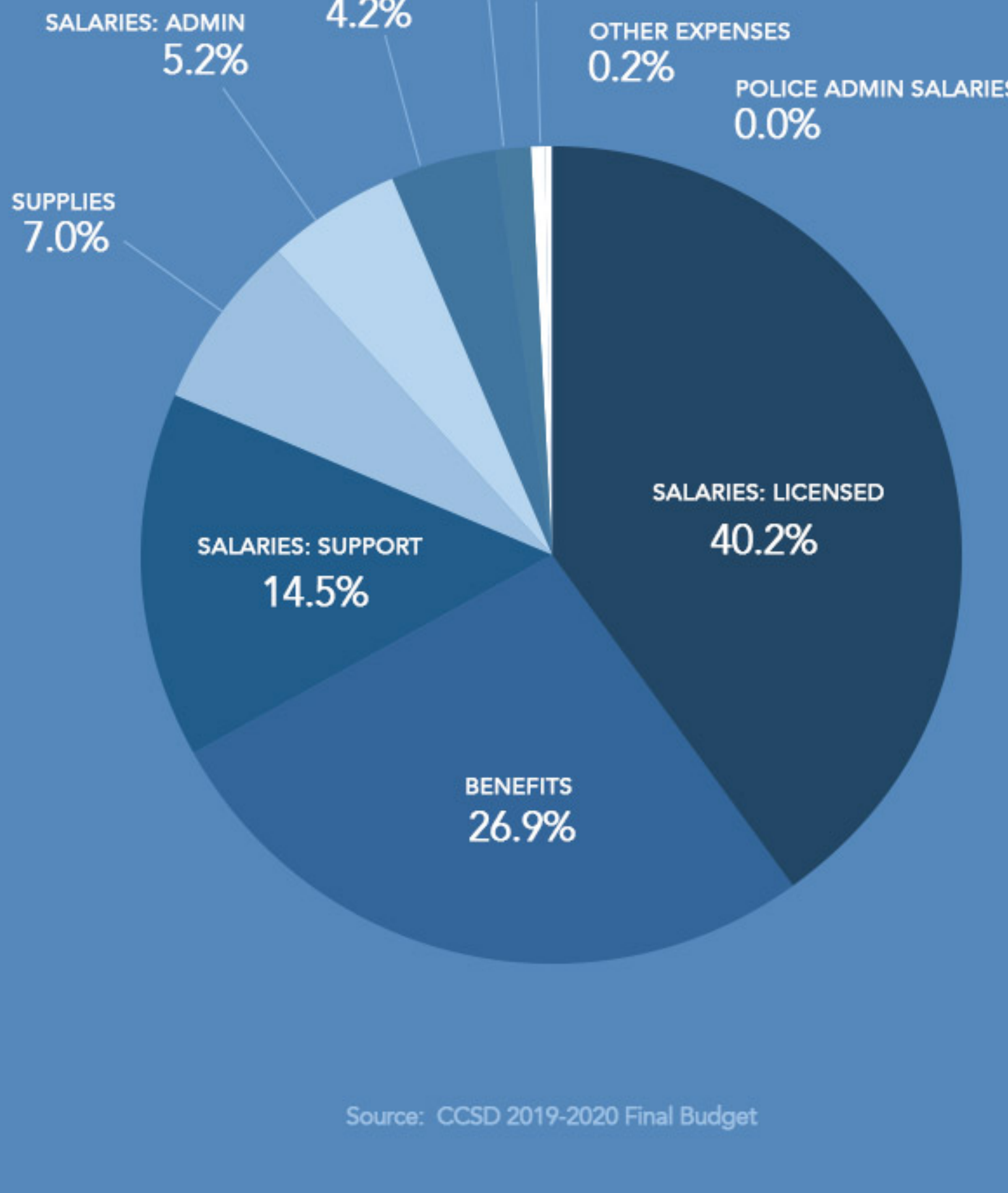
CCSD's general operating budget consists of all funds allocated to the District other than federal grant funds and bond funds. A general operating budget is much like a household's monthly budget, exclusive of gifts or one-time payments someone in the household might receive for a specific purpose. Here you can easily see what revenues come into the District and where they are invested.
