 - Nevada Report Card: The link will direct you to the Nevada Department of Education's Web site. Once there, you can use the Nevada Accountability Portal to view information at the school, district, or state level.

 - Budget Comparison: This interactive tool displays CCSD's budgeted amounts and staff positions by departmental areas.
 - **Department Analysis:** This interactive tool displays CCSD's budgeted amounts and positions for the General Operating Fund by department.
 - **Food Services Analysis:** This interactive tool displays CCSD's budgeted amounts and staff positions within the Food Services department.
 - Actual Salaries & Benefits by Function: This interactive tool displays the salaries and benefits for CCSD's general operating fund.
 - **AP Payments:** This interactive tool displays all CCSD payments made to vendors.
 - **Budget by School**: This interactive tool displays the school budgets by type.
 - NRS 388G Reporting: These reporting tools display the CCSD School Budgets as required by Nevada Revised Statutes (NRS) 388G for the specified fiscal year.
 - NRS 387.12468 Reporting: These reporting tools provide actual and budgeted reporting as required by NRS 387 for the specified fiscal year.

- 3. Click the Expand icon to enlarge either the bottom chart or the graphical chart.
- 4. Use the drop down menu to view the graphic details for a selected budget type.
- 5. Use the Navigation icons to reset, refresh, or export the data in PDF format.



Departmental Budget Analysis Dashboard

- The Departmental Budget Analysis tool compares the two most recent budgets for CCSD.
- The budget figures are captured in the Appropriation columns, while the number of employees within each Budget Type is found in the Position columns.
- The top chart is broken out by Fund Center (such as Deputy Superintendent, Instructional Services Unit, etc.).
- The bottom chart includes GL Accounts by Group Type and provides the amounts and number of positions for the budget types listed in the top chart.
- The graphic chart represents the amounts and number of positions for a selected budget type.



- 1. Click on the Fund Center field to expand into the Fund Center hierarchy details. This allows you to drill into the CCSD budgeted amounts and positions for the selected Fund Center.
- 2. When a field is selected in the top chart, the bottom chart and graph will automatically update to display only the details related to the selected Fund Center.
- 3. Click the Expand icon to enlarge either the bottom chart or the graphical chart.
- 4. Use the drop down menu to view the graphic details for a selected budget type.
- 5. Use the Navigation icons to reset, refresh, or export the data in PDF format.



Food Services Analysis Dashboard

- The Food Services Analysis tool compares the last two budgets for CCSD's Food Service department.
- The budget figures are captured in the Appropriation columns, while the number of employees within each Budget Type is found in the Position columns.
- The top chart is broken out by the Food Services Fund Center (such as Central Kitchen, Warehouse, etc.).
- The bottom chart is broken out by GL Account and provides the amounts and number of positions for the budget types listed in the top chart.
- The graphic chart represents the amounts and number of positions for a selected budget type.





- 1. Use the drop down menu to select the Food Services Fund Center and filter the dashboard charts. This allows you to drill into the CCSD budgeted amounts and positions for the selected Funds Center.
- 2. When a field is selected in the top chart, the bottom chart and graph will automatically update to display only the details related to the selected Food Services Fund Center.
- 3. Click the Expand icon to enlarge either the bottom chart or the graphical chart.
- 4. Use the drop down menu to view the graphic details for a selected budget type.
- 5. Use the Navigation icons to reset, refresh, or export the data in PDF format.



Actual Salaries & Benefits by Function Dashboard

- The Actual Salaries & Benefits by Function tool provides the General Operating Fund amounts for all employees across CCSD.
- The Salary figures are captured in the Amount columns, while the number of employees within the selected period is found in the Positions columns.
- The top chart includes GL Account Types by Function (Instruction, School Administrators, Central Services, etc.)
- The bottom chart is broken out by GL Account and provides the amounts and number of positions for the selected period listed in the top chart.
- The graphic chart represents the amounts and number of positions for a selected period range.



To navigate the Dashboard Tool:

- 1. Use the drop down menu to select the Function and filter the dashboard charts. This allows you to drill into the CCSD budgeted amounts and positions for the selected Function Type.
- 2. When a Function is selected in the top chart, the bottom chart and graph will automatically update to display only the GL Account details related to the selected Function.
- 3. Click the Expand icon to enlarge either the bottom chart or the graphical chart.
- 4. Use the Navigation icons to reset, refresh, or export the data in PDF format.

AP Payments Dashboard

- The AP Payments tool provides graphical and detailed views of all payments that have been paid to venders of CCSD.
- The dashboard includes the year-to-date total payment amount and number of transactions.
- A graph depicts the monthly payment totals with a comparison of the historical average monthly totals for the current fiscal year.
- The top five total payments is broken out by Function, Vendor, Fund
- The detailed view includes Pay Date, Vendor details, Fund, Functional Area, Accounting Document, and Pay Amount.

- The middle top chart displays the breakdown of Budget and Actuals by Budget Type (such as Salaries & Benefits, Services, etc.).
- The right top chart displays the breakdown of Budget and Actuals by Salaries and Benefits by Budget Type
- The bottom chart displays the breakdown of Budget and Actuals by the GL (General Ledger) Account and Description

Breaking Down the Budget

- The Breaking Down the Budget graphic shows the dollar amount of the budget at the student level.
- The Total Per Student Per Day amount is updated twice per fiscal year.
 - Final Budget
 - Amended Final Budget
- The formula used to calculate the Per Student Per Day amount is:

Total Budget for the Fiscal Year divided by Estimated Number of Students Enrolled in Schools Across CCSD divided by Total Number of Calendar Days in the School Year

BREAKING DOWN THE BUDGET The District's annual general operating budget is \$3.97 billion. If that seems like a large number coonsider this: we spend less than half of what other school districts close in size and demographics spend. Our \$3.97 billion budget broken out per student, per day helps put spending on expenditures like employees and supplies into perspective. **\$3,966,619,894/289,195/184** Days = PER STUDENT. PER DAY.





Breaking Down the Budget Per Student Per Day

- CCSD created the Breaking Down the Budget Per Student Per Day graphic to show how the Per Student Per Day amount is spent within the school district.
- This detail shows the breakdown of the Per Student Per Day amount as it translates to the different areas of the budget, such as Teacher Salaries and Benefits, Student Transportation, School Supplies, and School Police.
- The graphic is updated twice per fiscal year.

 - Clark County, NV
- The amounts are taken from the U.S. Census Bureau Annual Survey of School System Finances.
- This graphic is updated once per year as new numbers are published by the U.S. Census Bureau.
